We are so thankful for everyone who has come to help in the print shop this summer. We've had many volunteers during these past two months and, because of their work, we are over halfway done with the Chichewa project! Our goal is 200,000 of these bilingual English and Chichewa John & Romans scriptures to send to Malawi, Africa. We have 112,500 completely done and ready to be shipped.



We continue to print tracts in Pashto and Dari to be smuggled, in small quantities, into the Middle East.

Praise the Lord that the 40,000 pounds of scripture made it to Kenya, Africa! Pray it will clear customs quickly.

Praise the Lord for the building we have and all of the scripture that has been published in it. In 1996 we moved from the church building to our present building to our present building on the church property. We also praise the Lord that the ministry is doing well and growing. However, we have outgrown the space in this building.

We plan to expand in phases. The first phase of expansion will begin in September. We will remove our small warehouse wall. move electrical, set up a ceiling grid with new lights, and extend our HVAC. This will create 720 square feet of additional shop floor space. This phase will cost around \$15,000. Please pray that God will provide the funds at each phase. We currently have a \$10,000 donor match toward our overall goal. Clearly, God wants His word produced more than we do!
