Building Project Update

Plans are in the works to complete phase two of the building project this spring.

As you can see in the picture, the fork lift does not fit through the current door into the warehouse. Even if it did fit, there is a 6 inch step down that the fork lift cannot navigate.

The plan is to raise the floor and make an 8 foot by 8 foot opening so we can move between the warehouse and print shop without needing to go outside to move skids of scriptures.
