Puerto Rico Mission Trip 2023

On March 21, the 36 members of Team 1 assembled in Aguadilla, Puerto Rico. We worked alongside Iglesia Bautista Nueva Vida, Mayaguez, Pastor Luis Cuadrado.

Team 1 distributed 10,000 John and Romans with invitations to friend Sunday and ministered to 23 Pastors and their families during the retreat. The highlight of the pastors retreat is always Friday nights banquet. We served a delicious steak dinner to the Pastors and their wives while the children had a great time of food and games in a separate area of the church building. We love being a blessing to the pastors and their families. Friend Sunday was well attended and it is always a blessing to see new faces in church.

On the morning of March 28 Team 1 headed home and Team 2 began their trip to Aguadilla, Puerto Rico. This team was 33 members strong. Team 2 served alongside Iglesia Bautista Berea, Aguadilla, Pastor David Arroyo. We held a Vacation Bible School, Teen Mania, and a Friend Sunday. We were able to distribute 10,000 John and Romans with an invitation to VBS and friend Sunday. VBS and Teen Mania were energetic with a time for games, preaching and of course snacks. Friend Sunday was enjoyable with visitors in the pews and a lovely dinner with a time of fellowship.

Malawi, Africa, is hungry for the gospel



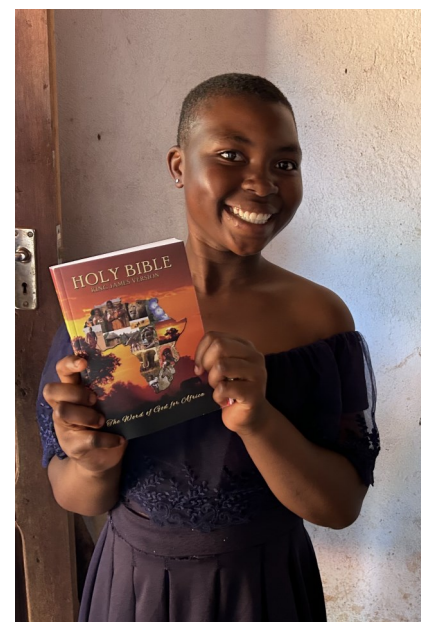
Many thanks to those of you that helped with the Chichewa scriptures! What a blessing to have sent two containers from our shop, and see them being distributed.

Ovi Cornea is actively distributing scriptures to police officers, police schools, hospitals, refugees, and more. One police officer told him, "I've never seen a Bible, never imagined that I would have my own - and all the people around me have one too!"

Campaigns for Christ, under Dave Darling, was able to distribute 250,000 scriptures in about 10 days!

These 2 groups have distributed about 2 containers full. Another container is on its way, and we are starting to assemble scriptures for a fourth container.
