On November 29, we were able to fill a container with 20 tons of scriptures and literature, totaling 347,804 pieces. It includes Chichewa John & Romans, bilingual Chichewa/English John & Romans, English whole Bibles, and tracts. The container is headed to Malawi, Africa, and two ministries, Hope for the Future and Campaigns for Christ, are ready, willing, and able to be the feet on the ground and distribute the scriptures.

Thank you to all the volunteers, churches, and the Couriers for Christ ministry that partnered with us to accomplish this. Please pray for the container as it will take two or three months of travel before it arrives in Malawi.
