The 46th Language Assembled In Our Shop!

In the central highlands and eastern parts of Chiapas in southern Mexico, there is a group of Tzeltal people. They are part of the larger Mayan ethnic group and speak the Tzeltal language, not Spanish or English. They do not have the Bible in their heart language.

The translation team pictured above has completed translating the New Testament and is working on the Old Testament. We are honored to be assembling 20,000 New Testaments for them. If the Lord wills, we will ship them by the end of September. Praise the Lord that material costs are covered, and please pray for the shipping expenses.

Letter from the Director:

As I reflect on what God has been doing at Bearing Precious Seed here in Oshkosh, I am reminded of Philippians 4:8: "Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things." There is so much of a "good report" to share.

For the first time in our ministry's history, we were working on four different languages on the same day in the shop! As you read on the first page, we have started our 46th language with the Tzeltal project. We were able to produce 10,000 English/Arabic John and Romans to be handed out as gifts at Christmas time in an Arabic-speaking country. We have also done a few custom jobs for churches here in the USA. We continue to work on 150,000 Tetum John and Romans for the island of East Timor, a project we shared about in our last letter.

We can never say thank you enough to all the volunteers who so faithfully come in day after day. As the demand for scripture has continued to rise, we have seen God's people continue to answer the call to help us produce these scriptures. We simply could not do what we do without folks just like you. Because so many of you pray, volunteer your time, and faithfully and sacrificially give of your finances, we are able to reach around the world with the good news of God's word. Often, people will receive scriptures from this print shop with your fingerprints on them, people who have never held the precious word of God before. Thank you.

Please note that from January 13 through May 6, 2025, we will be having multiple missions trips to the Caribbean. Evangelizing People In Caribbean (E.P.I.C.) is an outreach of Wyldewood Baptist Church. E.P.I.C. was born out of the desire to reach the people of the Caribbean with the



Gospel of Jesus Christ. We will be working hand in hand with national pastors, missionaries, and local churches on the various Caribbean islands. We would love to have you join us in this epic outreach opportunity. Please visit us at epic.wyldewood.org.
