Overflowing With Volunteers and Scriptures!

While celebrating the milestone of assembling over 700,000 scriptures in 2025, we are also recognizing a positive challenge: the need for more space! The Lord has blessed us with an incredible number of volunteers, averaging over 400 each month. On one Saturday in September, 42 people came to serve, and the shop was overflowing.

We recently purchased a used shipping container, which has helped in the short term, but it's only a temporary fix. Our shop can only hold supplies for one large project at a time, which often slows down production as we shuffle things around just to reach what we need.

We are grateful for this growth and for the volunteers God has sent our way! Please pray with us as we trust Him to provide the space needed to continue producing and sending more Scripture around the world.

Letter from the Director

"Faithful is he that calleth you, who also will do it." — I Thessalonians 5:24

"Who also will do it." Recently, I heard a sermon on this passage and was reminded that **it is God who does the work**—not us. What a blessing that He chooses to work through us when we yield to Him.

God continues to bless the Bearing Precious Seed ministry here at Wyldewood Baptist Church. We have had a record year of Scripture production. Just a few years ago, we were producing around 100,000 Scriptures annually. This year, we have already produced more than 700,000. Over the last few years, we have remodeled and rearranged our shop and warehouse, trying to optimize every inch of space. Yet as production numbers continue to rise, **we have quickly run out of room!**

To quote Nehemiah 2:20, "Then answered I them, and said unto them, The God of heaven, he will prosper us; therefore we his servants will arise and build." We are currently working with a commercial contractor on plans for a new building on Wyldewood's property in the northeast corner. This new facility will include a loading bay and dock for semis, much-needed office space (currently, Joe, Dan, and I share one small office), expanded production areas, and a larger warehouse. As we plan, we are also positioning the building for a future phase that would allow for an even larger warehouse.

Right now, we are praying for \$50,000 to hire an architect. **Please join us in prayer** as we follow God's leading. Our desire is to produce even more Scripture as He increases our capacity.

In October, we will return to North Carolina for the Southwide Conference, followed by a missions conference at Brentwood Baptist in Des Plaines, Illinois.




