Since 1979, the Bearing Precious Seed Ministry at Wyldeewood Baptist Church has been committed to one mission: producing God's word and distributing it around the world. What began in a small room has, by God's grace, grown into a ministry that has printed and distributed millions of scriptures in 46 languages.

The Lord continues to open doors for His word to reach new people and new places. As those opportunities have increased, so has the need for additional space to produce, store, and ship the scriptures entrusted to our care.

We believe this next expansion is not simply about constructing a larger building. It is about increasing our capacity to place God's word into the hands of people around the world for years to come.

Letter from the Director:

Since its humble beginnings in a small upstairs room in the church building, our ministry has experienced continual growth. As the Lord blessed the ministry, that small space soon became inadequate. Walls were built to create a dedicated shop within the church building, and by the 1980s the ministry had expanded into the church gymnasium to meet the increasing demand.

As the need continued to grow, a warehouse was constructed on the church property, and in 1996 a fully functioning, one-level print shop was attached to the north side of that warehouse. Since then, millions of copies of God's word have been printed, shipped, and distributed to people around the world.

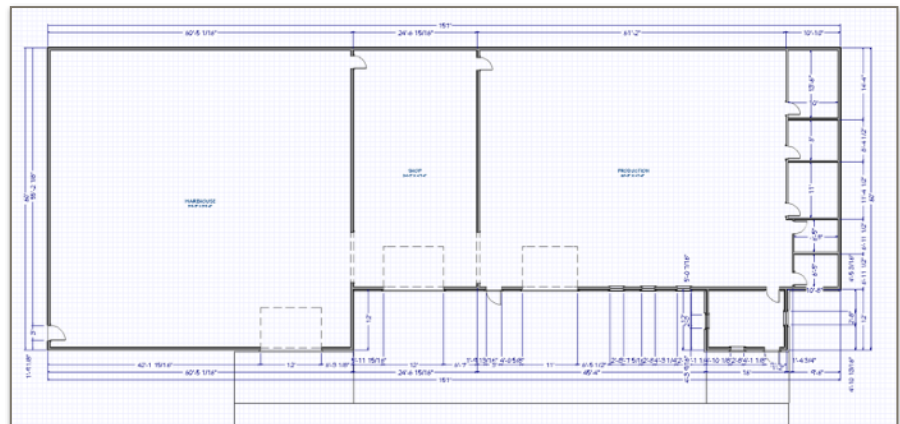
Over the past several years, we have worked diligently to maximize every square foot of our current facility. Storage has become so limited that we now rely on both a 40-foot shipping container and a 20-foot shipping container to hold overflow supplies. We are grateful for how God has blessed this ministry, and we desire to continue being faithful stewards of the resources He has entrusted to us.

After much prayer, careful planning, and wise counsel from our pastor and others whose wisdom we deeply value, we believe the Lord is leading us to take the next step in the ministry's growth. This expansion will take place in several phases, and we would be glad to share those plans with anyone who would like additional details.

The first phase will be the construction of a 60-by-60-foot steel warehouse on the south side of our current print shop. The clear-span design will provide an open, unobstructed workspace, and the foundation will require extra thick reinforced concrete to support the equipment and materials it will hold for many years to come. Initial expenses include architectural plans and the construction of the foundation.

We would greatly appreciate your continued prayers as we move forward with this next chapter of the Bearing Precious Seed Ministry at Wyldewood Baptist Church. We also ask that you prayerfully consider partnering with us as we work to expand our capacity to produce and distribute God's word to millions more people in the years ahead.
